FAQ

What do Podiatrists do?

Podiatrists are the primary health care provider for foot and related lower limb conditions.

Do Orthotics change my foot shape?

No. Orthotics are used purely as an aide to "hold" your feet into a more efficient position to help relieve and prevent pain or improve function.

Will I need Orthotics forever?

No. Only certain foot conditions and foot postures require long term orthotic use. Many require orthoses in the management of their particular injury and rehabilitation.

How are Sports Orthotics different to Rigid Orthotics?

Sports Orthotics are made with different movements of the foot in mind. For example foot stresses in straight-line walking are quite different from multidirectional sports such as football or netball.

How long will it take to get used to having orthotics in my shoe?

This will vary between a 3-10 days. It is advised you slowly break them in over this time (increase by 1 hour per day). At the 2 week review your podiatrist will make slight adjustments if necessary.

Does Private Health Insurance cover orthotics?

Most private health funds pay a rebate on orthotics every calendar year ranging from \$120-\$500. Please check with your health fund if you are unsure of your cover.
